

CCS Family:

We're beginning preparations for the 2011-2012 school year here in the administration building. 2010-11 has certainly been challenging as we've fought to maintain a feasible budget with lower enrollment, but it has been wonderful to watch parents, teachers, and students buy in to the educational ministry of our school. And currently, we've actually grown by double digits during the school year—that does not typically happen in private education, and we're very happy to welcome the many new families that have partnered with us.

Enclosed you'll find re-enrollment information, a tuition schedule, and a financial contract for the 2011-2012 school year. Early registration will stay open until February 15th, at which point we'll begin a spring marketing campaign to fill whatever spots remain available. We're also rolling out an online enrollment procedure from a link on our homepage. Please bear with us as we work the kinks out, but it will greatly reduce the paperwork you deal with and improve our office efficiency.

We have a couple of classes that are near or over capacity. Because I try to avoid making the same mistakes twice, let me ensure you that we will not accept more than our published class size for next year. Our physical facilities and minimal staffing mean that we can only accept as many students as we can teach effectively.

K3: 10 students

K4-1st grade: 16 students

2nd – 6th grade: 18 students

7th – 10th grade: 20 students. 11th – 12th grade: 22 students

Once a class is full, we will begin a waiting list. We will split a class once it's financially feasible. The numbers above indicate that our school, as currently staffed, could accommodate 262 students. To put that in perspective, 262 students at our current per-student average would have brought a surplus of \$181,000 into this school year. Our long-term solution, then, must be a full school.

The board has authorized a 10% tuition discount for any family that prepays before February 8th for the next school year; that discount will drop to 5% through March 8th, and 2% through June 8th.

Families enrolled through our IBT program will need to visit factstuitionaid.com for verification of their tuition amount before re-enrolling.

You'll also see that our complicated tuition and fee structures have changed. Now, you see one number for tuition. We have removed yearbooks and school photos from the tuition structure. This year completes our contract with our yearbook provider. In the future, we will use a print-on-demand company, allowing parents to order books at their discretion (which means you'll no longer pay for 3 yearbooks just because you have three children). Please bear with me as we continue to negotiate with the yearbook company for last year's books. School photos will also be ordered as desired.

The final (and largest) change to our tuition structure affects our FACTS debit program. Beginning with the 2011-2012 school year, families who have not paid in full prior to the start of school will have 8% of the balance assessed as a fee for using the FACTS program. This is designed to ensure that the

maximum number of families pay up front, which is another factor affecting our long-term stability. Many families who wish to avoid an 8% fee may wish to visit a local bank, where they should be able to find a lesser rate.

Also, rather than charging an assortment of fees up front, we will simply require a down-payment of 10% before the first day of school. Please note also that all school accounts must be current in order to re-enroll for 2011-2012.

I know that's a lot of information, with some fairly major changes, to absorb in a single letter. If you have questions, feel free to call or email. Thank you for supporting our school, for giving us the freedom to make the necessary changes, and as always:

Financial Contract

1. I understand that upon signing this contract, **I am responsible for a one- year obligation to Cornerstone Christian School for a full payment of my child's or children's tuition.**
 - a. After a student has been registered, an early withdrawal fee of \$500.00 will be charged prior to June 1, 2011. *
 - b. On or after June 1, 2011, all tuition and fees for the remainder of the upcoming school year are due regardless of child's attendance and will be pursued. *
 - c. In registering my child(ren) for the 2011 -2012 school year, I pledge and promise the payment of all school tuition, fees and related expenses. **Please initial** _____ .*
2. Report cards and transcripts will not be released to the family or another school if accounts are past due. In order to receive report card, transcripts, or take part in extra-curricular activities, payments must be received in cash, money order or by cashier's check.
3. If my child leaves during the contract year, **THE ENTIRE YEAR'S TUITION IS DUE AND PAYABLE.** *No records or transcripts will be forwarded to another school until this obligation is met in full.* The only exceptions to the above policy are:
 - a. A student is immediately expelled from CCS. (Note: students who are asked to leave as a result of long-term disciplinary issues that have been forewarned by administration will still be responsible for payment of tuition in full.)
 - b. A student's family makes a legitimate move out of the area.
4. A student who has voluntarily withdrawn during the school year may not be readmitted for a period of one year except by recommendation of the School Administration and the approval by the School Board Executive Committee. To be eligible for the exception, the entire year's tuition for the year of withdrawal must have been paid in full.
5. If the conditions of this Financial Contract are not kept, the account will be turned over to an attorney for collection or small claims court. In the event that this occurs, you will be responsible for any and all attorney and collection fees. I agree to pay court costs, collection fees, a reasonable attorney fee, and other expenses incurred by the school in enforcing this agreement. Furthermore, I understand that at any time there exists an unpaid indebtedness to the school, all records, reports and transcripts will be withheld. **Please initial** _____ .*
6. In order to take part in extracurricular events, all accounts must be kept current.
7. Your account must be current in order to re-enroll for the 2011-12 school year.
8. All accounts that are in arrears as of May 15, 2011, will have additional financial requirements put in place for the 2011-12 school year.
